Having conquered Hollywood, Mary Cay, at fifty, completed her Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology and Social Work followed by a Masters of Arts in Education at the College of Santa Fe New Mexico. Her ability to communicate inspiringly with all kinds of people was put to good use helping the needy of New Mexico while continuing to help the growing film industry in New Mexico.

Mary Cay and Ward's love of New Mexico and their desire to travel, for knowledge and pleasure, made it an easy decision to refocus Ward's passion for photography from Hollywood cinematography to Santa Fe still photography. The last fifteen years have found them ever together, traveling to the far corners of the world, learning, laughing, loving and taking world class photographs to supply the ever increasing demand at their WARD RUSSELL Gallery of Photography in Santa Fe.

Mary Cay is survived by her loving husband Ward Russell, devoted cat Calli, loving families around the States and an enormous amount of loving friends around the world who will always remember her as that very special person who brought a very special happiness into their lives.
